## CUTTING-EDGE VIRTUAL REALITY SURGEON ANNOUNCED AS 2017 BRITISH BANGLADESHI PERSON OF YEAR

Shafi Ahmed was last night announced as the most influential British Bangladeshi at a prestigious event held at the Shard, in London.

Shafi scoops the 'Person of the Year' 2017 award for his extraordinary achievement in performing the world's first virtual reality operation. Medical experts hope Shafi's pioneering live-streamed surgeries in virtual reality and with Snapchat will make healthcare fairer and boost training.

Celebrating its sixth year, the British Bangladeshi Power & Inspiration (BBPI) list is a celebration of the success of the UK's Bangladeshi community.

Guests at the event included a wide spectrum of the British Bangladeshi community including leading entrepreneurs, social activists and global philanthropists.

The previous winners of the award are Nadiya Hussain, who rose to fame on the BBC's Great British Bake off and the Honourable Judge Khatun Sapnara, the first British Bangladeshi promoted to a senior judicial position at the Crown Court.

The organisers also announced that applicants can now apply for funding and mentoring support from the BBPI Foundation.
